

Whilst we saw a seasonably low haul for December with 63 recoveries valued at a total of £1.35m, there was nothing seasonal about what was stolen with items ranging from tractors to caravans.

The most valuable recovery was that of an £80,000 Bentley Continental from West Yorkshire, stolen of course with keys as were 78% of all the cars recovered in December.

In the car section, British build was de rigueur with Bentley, Jaguar and Range Rover taking the first 4 places.

Our lowest valued recovery was a £1,500 motor scooter!
